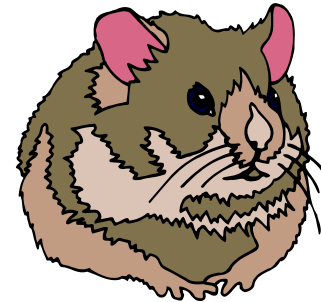

YEAR 3 TOPICS Summer Term 2011

Children, welcome to the busy summer term. The weather has been warming up so I hope we can get outside quite a bit this term and use the outdoor learning environment. Parents, this leaflet provides details of the topics planned for your child to study this term. P.E./GAMES

Areas to be covered this term include: swimming, athletics and ball games (Tri-golf & Kwik Cricket).

ENGLISH/ LITERACY

We will continue to build up a creative language word bank which will aid creative writing. We will be investigating Adventure and Mystery stories, developing characters and settings, looking at how authors create suspense, all with the aim of producing our own. We will also be studying non-chronological reports. We will continue to use the 'Letters and Sounds' and 'Support for Writing' programmes in order to help the children with their spellings. We will also be introducing the children to 'writing toolboxes' which we hope they can use to improve their writing across different genres.

MATHS/NUMERACY

Numeracy is organised into five blocks. We will be covering Unit 3 of each of the five blocks of work, focusing on counting, partitioning and calculating, securing number facts, understanding shape, handling data and measures. Broken down further this involves work on addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, number patterns, sequences, problem solving, 2D and 3D shapes, frequency tables, Venn diagrams, measurements and time and money problems.

SCIENCE

A focus on investigations and experiments, linked to plants and a mission incredible investigation. The emphasis will be on undertaking fun and interesting investigations that the children will enjoy.

GEOGRAPHY

We will continue to focus on Weather Around The World and will be comparing our 'fantastic' weather with that of other countries!

HISTORY

We will continue to examine and investigate some of the questions posed by the children about the Roman period. There will be cross curricular links with Art and ICT.

I.C.T.

We will continue to work on improving word processing skills. Children will be encouraged to type with both hands to improve their speed. We will also be looking at Modelling and Simulations. Work will be also linked to the Numeracy, Literacy, Science, Geography and History curriculums.

ART

Art will continue to be linked to our topic work. There will be a focus on Roman art.

D&T

We will be making Roman shields.

MUSIC

Ongoing singing skills, exploring rounds, listening to music and performing—all undertaken in PPA lessons. We will be learning and singing songs linked to our Christmas performance.
